Photo Use Policy

Including photos of people and events at New Hope Presbyterian Church within our public publications is a privilege for us, and we intend to respect and honor it. “Public publications” are defined as the website and printed or electronic materials intended for distribution to both members and non-members of New Hope Presbyterian Church. Therefore:

- Photos are almost always of people in public spaces, and/or at public events.
- We will not knowingly utilize photos that would be embarrassing, objectionable or hurtful to anyone in the photo.
- We do not identify children or youth by name in the photos we print or post online.
- We will maintain a list of names for those who request pictures of them or their children not be used and will strive to honor each request.
- We will respectfully remove any photo upon request. If you see a photo that includes you or your child and would like it removed from the website or electronic material, please call the church office with the details.

We ask for your respect in return. Unless otherwise indicated, photographs on the website or other printed materials are the property of and are copyrighted by New Hope Presbyterian Church and may not be used for any purpose (including but not limited to: downloading, printing, distributing, linking) without expressed permission from New Hope Presbyterian Church.

Photos of people and events may also be included in private publications. “Private publications” are defined as printed or electronic materials intended only for members of New Hope Presbyterian Church (e.g., the Member Directory). The Photo Use Policy as stated above applies to private publications with the exception that children or youth depicted in photos may be identified by name.
